The eschatological "End of Days" is imminent

This is the 94th press campaign which has been published during the last few decades only in Israeli newspapers, the latest mostly in Russian.

The first time I set foot in the Land of Israel along with my family in 1965, I was given the task of taking care of 384 sheep in Kibbutz Ayelet HaShachar. I never had the opportunity during that trip to visit Jerusalem. It was only after officially moving to the land of our forefathers on April 4th, 1967, that I finally got the chance to visit there. I went along with my friend, Dr. Yossi Rivlin, who is a relative of the President, and Leo Savir, who was then working for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (and also the father of Uri Savir, who would later be in charge of the Oslo Accords negotiations, back then he was merely attending primary school). Both showed me around the city. When we went up to Mt. Zion, I asked them to let me walk around on my own. I went up to the tower of the Abbey of the Dormition, where the last supper had taken place. It was there that I called out to the God of our forefathers and asked Him to unify the city, and eyes facing north, to return the lands of Judea and Samaria back to us. My prayer was heard and fulfilled during the Six Day War. The city of Jerusalem was reunified on June 7th. It was just one of many prayers that have been heard during my lifetime.

God is also speaking nowadays

Many years ago, I heard the words of the Holy one, blessed be He, in a vision in the night. He said to me:

"I will not rest until this people (Israel) is again my people and I will be Elohim for them again!"

Therefore, it isn't surprising that all the peace-building efforts in this region have failed so far. And still, the President of the United States, Donald Trump, intends to follow up with George W. Bush's road map. According to that, Israel should pull back behind the borders of 1967. However, it is the will of the God of our forefathers that the conquered lands be annexed by the Nation of Israel. All the more so, as the Arab inhabitants living in these lands meanwhile only ran them down for centuries and didn't develop or cultivate them at all! And be sure, the rightful owner of these lands still is and remains the Holy One, blessed be He, Him alone and no other. Therefore, Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu will do right not to agree to any deal Mr. Trump could offer, who hasn't learned a thing from his predecessors' mistakes.

After all the terrorist activities perpetrated by Palestinians of the "West Bank" and the rocket barrages fired from the Gaza Strip by terrorist organizations like Hamas and various other Jihadist groups, it is an illusion to expect sustainable peace with those same Palestinians. And Israel, due to its problematic geo-strategic situation in the area, cannot give up any more of these vital territories which are essential to the basic security needs of our people (for example, the Jordan Valley, etc.).

There is no doubt that Israel, in refusing any kind of such a deal, is increasingly being isolated internationally, as correctly prophesied by the prophets in the Bible. But the formerly "Christian" nations have forgotten that the hatred towards Jews and the murderous persecution directed against them during the many centuries of our nation's exile is based on reasons that are concealed by the Holy One, blessed be He. He thus expresses his wrath and justice, and the churches do not understand that the establishment of the Jewish state thus was indeed "the dawn of our redemption." The ingathering of the exiles into the land of our forefathers was already accurately described in chapter 37 in the Book of Ezekiel the prophet.

The story of the “dry bones” (reference in Ezekiel) always reminds me of the bodies of the many Jewish brothers and sisters who are no longer alive and perished in the Nazi’s concentration camps. I myself am only a “brand plucked out of the fire” of that hell since God revealed himself to me on a winter’s day when I was three years old in the city of Linz by the River Danube, and the gates of heaven opened up. I know the honor of God, who granted me a moment of supreme bliss and then caused me to lose consciousness while falling on my face into the snow showing no signs of life. That same year, at the start of World War II, I saw with my own eyes the oppressor and mass murderer named Adolf Hitler, who requested to be buried in Linz. In this Austrian city, the lines of good and evil crossed paths. And God is my witness that I am telling the truth. The fact that He did not stop the murder of His people and let it happen should with necessity have caused, especially our rabbis and the leaders of our nation, to conduct an in-depth and serious soul-searching. After all, about 80% of Polish Jews at that time were ultra-Orthodox, though this did not save them from their enemies.

The metaphysical dimension of peace for Israel

As a matter of fact our Sages do not understand what is written in the Bible in regard to all things pertaining to true peace. Isaiah 2:2-5 states unequivocally that peace will come from Zion, and the nations will learn to abandon all wars. The key figure in this context is the Messiah, whose name is also God-Hero, as is written in Isaiah 9:5. The Christian churches have until this day failed to accurately translate this verse and therefore have failed to understand that the Messiah is also the “wondrous advisor”, God’s emissary. The paternal relationship between the Holy One, blessed be He, and Him is expressed by his other name, My-Father-is-everlasting (Avi-ad), who loved his only son (see also Micah 5:3 and Zachariah 12:10). And it definitely does not matter if our religious institutions or any of the other religions accept this or not, since in the Kingdom of God this already is an indisputable fact.

So too, it is also a fact that Yeshua is the Messiah of the Lord, made in His image and His emissary, the “servant of God,” according to Isaiah 53, and there is no other to be expected. He also rendered his soul as an offering for sin (Isaiah 53:10), in which he redeemed every person and forgives them their sins. It is the refusal, stubbornness and lack of understanding of our “sages” that keep us cut off from our own Messiah’s message. In His disgraceful death (which nevertheless fulfilled divine prophecy!), He became a sort of *agent provocateur* by posing as a “failure” from a humanly historical perspective, however, he will appear in due course of these eschatological End of Days with the power and strength of His Lord on the Mount of Olives. He will then put an end to the distress of His people (s. Zachariah 14:3; Isaiah 52:6; Micah 5:3).

Since the Christian nations continue to adhere to and are infected by supersessionism/replacement theology (according to which the Christian church has succeeded and taken the place of the Nation of Israel as the definitive Chosen Nation), they have lost the understanding of the purpose and function of our Jewish nation. The State of Israel is in fact only a political entity with no redeeming qualities ever since the Jews forfeited their Messiah, in their view, by rendering him to the death on a Roman cross. And while Talmudic Judaism is still struggling with “keeping the commandments of the Torah of Moses”, Jeremiah the Prophet already described in 31:31-34 the creation of a **new** covenant (“**It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors**”, i.e. the Mt.-Sinai-covenant) which will be a covenant of intimate knowledge. And as long as our rabbis cry out “may his (Jesus Christ’s) name and memory be obliterated” (this is what the Hebrew acronym “Yeshu” refers to) and consider Him to be “the hire of an harlot” as stated in the Talmud, there will be no end to the plight of our Nation of Israel.

The plight of Israel in the End of Days

The Lord’s roadmap will not alter, since there is no “Prince of Peace” other than the Messiah Yeshua. “The remnant of Jacob will return” at the end of the process, according to Isaiah 10:20-22. And the address is no other than the very same “God-Hero” as before (conf. c. 9:5 f) who is none other than the Messiah Himself, who in his death redeemed not only humanity, but first and foremost the Nation of

Israel. And it is precisely our nation that has added to my great sorrow by despising our own Savior. His primary goal was to create a path towards forgiveness of our sins and the resurrection of our bodies for an eternal life, and not necessarily for a narrow political victory over the armies of our enemies. The prophet Zachariah referenced this in Chapter 12, where he wrote that “all the surrounding peoples” will gather for war against our nation. But Jerusalem will be an “immovable rock for all the nations,” such that even President Trump’s hands will become all torn sore in an attempt to solve the question of peace in the Middle East. This question will constitute for the nations “a cup of venom for all the people round about” which they will need to empty, something which has been weakly and inaccurately translated in Christian Bibles as merely an intoxicating cup – rather than terminal and fatal.

Since the age of ten, I have diligently studied the Old Testament as well as the New Testament under guidance from the Spirit of the Lord and not the Jewish or Christian theologians. With the latter I sat for 26 years on the Theological Convention of the Evangelical confessing Churches in Germany. However, my attempts to influence those theologians in favor of recognizing the virtues of the eternal choice of our nation by the Holy One, blessed be He, did not bear any fruit! The Christians among the nations continue to focus on achieving personal redemption and the resurrection of their flesh from the dead due to their faith in the Jewish Messiah, Jesus, instead of inviting the Nation of Israel to return to the open arms of the Messianic hero who waits patiently.

The Islamization of Europe

On September 11, 2003, I spoke at a police conference on the topic of “The Religious Background of Islamic Terror.” I referred to, amongst other things, all the passages within the Koran that call for criminal behavior, including the call to murder members of the other faiths. The officers and senior police officials who were present knew nothing about the potential violence which is deeply engrained into the roots of the Muslim faith and which fosters extremism to the point of mass murder and suicide attacks (martyrdom).

Nevertheless, today millions of Muslims from Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya and other African nations are migrating to Europe, with Germany being their preferred destination, in order to get free healthcare services, housing, language courses, around 450 Euros per month for living expenses and jobs in the West; in short, everything that they didn’t have in their homelands. And it’s only a matter of time before 1.5 million members of a foreign faith and culture (who are making their homes in Europe thanks to the help of Chancellor Merkel, a former deputy spokesperson of the East German government) will join the 4½ million Muslims already there. They will change the face of the society there beyond recognition and they will undermine Europe’s Christian foundations, namely the instilled rests of Jewish Messianism, of the disappearing Western world. The election of 38-year-old Emmanuel Macron to the French presidency, a man who has come out in the past as a supporter of Muslims, only sets the seal on this disastrous development. No wonder that his first visit was dedicated to honoring like-minded Chancellor Merkel.

The Messiah Yeshua foretold us the sequence of events in Matthew 24, when he warned against false prophets (Muhammed for example) who would “deceive many people.” Added to this today is a narrow and one-dimensional way of thinking that limits human intelligence; in which the Christian theologians excel at interpreting the miracles and wonders created by God as mere myths and legends, which undermines every vital belief and faith we should have. The ruler of the dark side, his spirits and his servants will know to fill the spiritual void created by this way of thinking. With regard to human reason, German philosopher Kant is rightly said to having voided the Creation of the Creator. The style of critical historical interpretations subjugates the Word of God to the limitations of human reason and control, but doesn’t know how to answer the ontological questions regarding the ultimate meaning of existence. The period of the End of Days before the return of the Messiah will be characterized by scarcity, increasing injustice, wars, earthquakes and other natural disasters as described by Jesus in the aforementioned chapter. We continue to ignore all this information found in the Old and New Testament.

Similarly, the fact that the new ruler of the Middle East is named Vladimir Putin is entirely ignored. Russia is the new superpower in our region, does as it sees fit and undermines the region to its core. After all, Russia today is in fact the deciding factor regarding both Syria and Iran, which is also aided by Kim Jong-un, the ruler of the isolated North Korea. Iran not only seeks to equip itself with intercontinental ballistic missiles, but mainly to get their hands on fissile materials (even plutonium) for making nuclear bombs. Ayatollah Khamenei did already boast in the past a single bomb would suffice to destroy the hated "Zionist entity".

This sequence of events will serve the will of the Holy One, blessed be He, in enticing "Gog from the land of Magog", i.e. Russia, to come to the mountains of Israel with the aim to settle an account with him, and provide an opportunity to put an end to this dangerous enemy right here (Ezekiel 38). All of this is a certainty as if it has already come to pass and no power in the world can stop it.

The writings in the New Testament seem to add to and shed more light on what was already implied in the Old Testament in order to more accurately describe the chain of events and the reasons behind it all. I would like to encourage the reader to confront and thoroughly study these prophecies which pertain to the period known as the "End of Days." For when UNESCO, and others as well, already take the Palestinian position and gradually adopt the language of undermining the right of the Jewish people to Jerusalem and its holy places, it will prove their wicked ignorance of biblical history. It is clear that in the end, Israel will stand alone against the nations of the world and will only be able to rely on our Lord and Father.
